I want to first apologize for our lack of reporting so far this year. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we catch up. God has been doing some wonderful things with His ministry and we are thankful for your vital part in it.

A few weeks ago, three big boxes containing Bibles, Hymnals, and school supplies were sent to two different Filipino Churches to help with new church plants as well as upcoming Vacation Bible Schools and Bible Clubs. Twice as many supplies were sent this year for less than half the cost! Praise God for showing us a better way to ship needed supplies to the Philippines! VBS Express was a definite success this year!

We were also able to have a part in helping the great work of Bro. Johnny Leslie in Croatia. Their church was in need of baptismal robes, and we were able to provide those within a few weeks time.

In February I had a unique opportunity to visit Anchor Baptist Church in Melbourne, Australia. I was able to see first-hand the work of Bro. Abrell, Bro. Blanchard, and Bro. Back. During my time there I preached four times, we handed out hundreds of tracts, and tried to be an encouragement. Please pray for God to provide ABC a permanent location for \$20,000 or less. Also, pray for more missionaries to answer the call to Australia. This country has a great need for missionaries.

Before I left on my trip, I met with Bradley Reppond, Missionary to South Korea. We are helping him prepare for deputation by designing a prayer card and a letterhead. He has excellent goals and a great vision for the people God has called him to. If you would be interested in hearing from him please let us know.

Finally, God allowed us to have a part in putting a Filipino Jeepney back into service. I was in the Philippines last year and know how coveted these vehicles are for bringing people to church and many can't get one. Pastor Shane Ogdie was in the Philippines in January and reported about a church that has one, but it needed major engine and steering repairs. Woodland Hills Baptist Church and HOME TEAMS sent the needed funds to fix it. All the repairs are completed and they were also able to put the name of the church on the side and replace all four tires that were completely bald. They were very thankful and sent a video of the Jeepney full of people at church. Praise God!
