Deputation

Over the past two months we have presented our ministry in six different churches and have had two churches pick us up for monthly support. It has been a blessing to be a part of missions revivals and it is always exciting to learn of more missionaries that we will be able to help in the future. What a privilege to serve God and His choicest servants!

The set of Betty Lukens flannel graph was cut out, sent, and received by the Gansemer family, missionaries to Argentina. This will be a blessing as the Gansemers begin a new church later this year.

BookIt! To Uganda was a great success and a huge encouragement to missionary James Huckabee and his family. In April, we delivered 6,683 books, 796 magazines, and several boxes of educational resources and Bibles to Missouri and helped arrange them in the basement of the home where the Huckabees are staying while on furlough. Thank you to all the churches who had a part in donating these materials!

VBS Express was another project that we were able to complete in April. This project allowed us to equip missionary Francis Teodoro with sufficient school supplies for 100 children. These supplies will be given out during their Vacation Bible School in the coming weeks. We will be sending these supplies to Bro. Teodoro each year, so it's still not too late to help with VBS Express! We will most likely ship for VB 2014 in January of next year.

In April we began to send medical supplies to John & Lena Allen, medical missionaries to Papua New Guinea. We are shipping boxes every two weeks. So far we have been able to send 6 good-sized boxes to them! We are excited to be able to help this wonderful work in PNG. The opportunity to help with Operation: Duffle Drop is coming to a close. We are trying to locate military style duffle bags for the Cone family. They only need 8 more duffle bags by the end of May!

At this point, the missionaries and nationals will be doing minor formatting changes and a final read through. The final product will be sent to the printers this Summer while Bro.
