New Project

‘A Blessed Hope Christmas’ is our newest project. Gary & Meghann Wiggins are the directors of Blessed Hope Boys Academy in Alabama, a home for troubled teenage boys. We would like to show the staff and boys at this home the love of Christ through sending them love this Christmas. This is an opportunity for a church, group, or family to “adopt” a boy or staff member. If you are unable to take on the full responsibility for a person—you can still help through sending what you are able to help with. The main gift to each child will be a **handmade** twin sized blanket or quilt for their beds. These can be sewn, crocheted, or knitted. Other gifts we would like to send include King James Bibles, new clothing, new shoes, and stocking stuffers. Many of the boys have already been “adopted” but there are several that still need to be assigned. If you would like to help in any way, please let us know.
